CLASS INFORMATION

All events subject to 2018 AQHA rules regarding AQHA membership and ownership as stated in AQHA rule book. AQHA policies regarding humane treatment and drug policies shall be strictly enforced.

Due to the size and number of entries in this show, management will make every attempt to accommodate all exhibitors concerning class conflicts, including adjusting work orders in individual work classes, but will not hold any class for an exhibitor: the ultimate decision on conflicting classes is the responsibility of the exhibitor. RULES FOR TEXAS AMATEUR STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS 2018

Individual Circuit Champions - Amateur, Amateur Select, Novice Amateur

1. Contestants must be a current Texas Amateur QHA member before their first qualifying class begins.
2. Contestants must enter and show under five of six judges
3. Points will be tabulated on a one horse/one rider basis according to the AQHA rules for show points. AQHA Rules will apply in all cases, with the additional restrictions listed here.
4. The winner will be the rider/horse combination with the greatest total points. Ties will be broken by the most first place wins.
5. Points will be counted only from AQHA Amateur, Select, or Novice Amateur classes.

All Around - Amateur, Youth, Junior & Senior

Highpoint Awards - Novice Amateur, Novice Youth & Amateur Select

1. Contestants must be a current Texas Amateur QHA member before their first qualifying class begins.
2. Points will be tabulated on a one horse/one rider basis per AQHA All Around rules for show point. AQHA Rules shall apply in all cases with the additional rules listed herein.
3. The All Around winner will be the horse/rider combination with the most total points. In the event of a tie, the awards will go to the horse/rider combination earning points in the most classes, and if still tied, then to the horse/rider combination with the greatest number of first places.
4. Points will be counted only from AQHA approved classes for Amateur and Select Amateur All Around, and approved Novice classes for Novice Amateur All Around.
5. Halter will count but is not mandatory including Novice. Novice can show in their corresponding Youth classes and the points will count.

Big Country QHA Awards:

- Youth - Novice Youth - All Around and Reserve All Around
Youth, and Novice Youth must show in a minimum of three performance classes under four of six judges. The top two highest point totals of youth and novice youth will win circuit and reserve circuit.
- Open (Junior & Senior) - Youth - Novice Youth Circuit Awards
Open, Youth and Novice Youth must show under four judges for circuit awards.

LEADLINE • WALK TROT

Open to riders 11 years of age or under as of January 1, 2018, AQHA rules regarding status, membership, or ownership of the horse do not apply; the horse or pony may be of any breed and it is not necessary for the rider to own the horse. Lead Line riders cannot ride in Walk Trot. Riders in the Walk Trot class may only compete in Walk Trot. They may not compete in other riding classes at this show.
